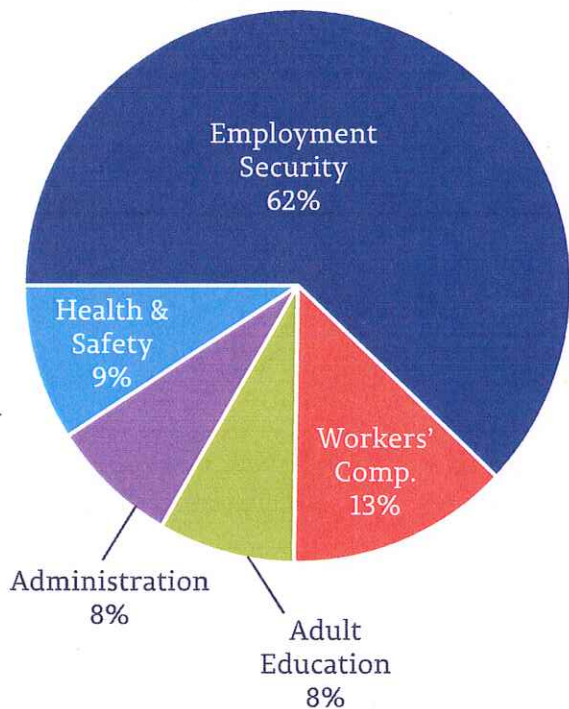

## ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

- Enforces adherence to state and federal labor laws.
- Review, mediate, and pay workers' compensation and unemployment claims.
- Partner with Tennessee Colleges of Applied Science and Community Colleges to provide high school equivalency exams and workforce training.
- Inspect boilers, elevators, and amusement devices to certify safety standards are met.

## ITEMS TO MEET REDUCTION TARGETS

- *Workers' Compensation:* Reduce four full-time vacant positions.
- *Adult Education:* Reduction of grant expenditures.

## COST INCREASE REQUESTS

- *Workers' Compensation:* Workers' Compensation Research Institute (WCRI), participate in study on the effectiveness of Workers' Compensation reform laws.
- *Workers' Compensation:* Security upgrades for three workers' compensation offices (Murfreesboro, Gray, and Cookeville).
