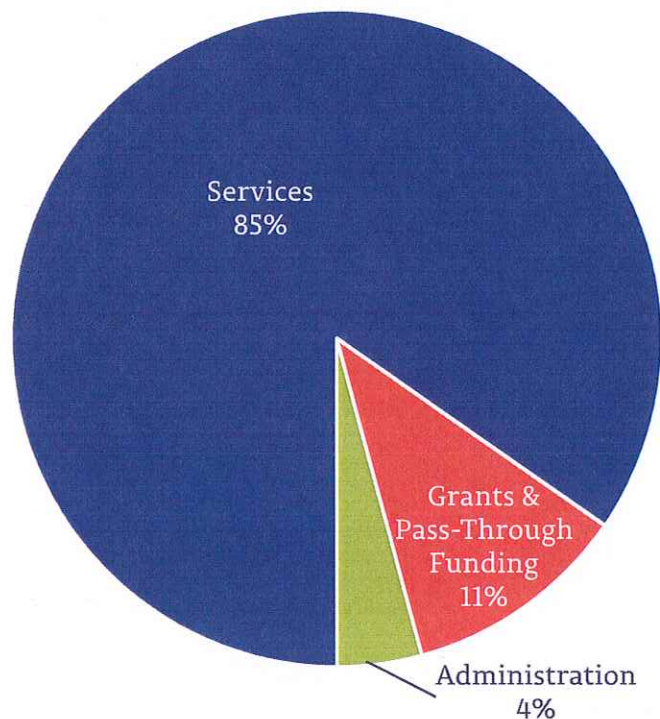

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

- Sixty percent of TennCare funding is paid to Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) to provide medical, behavioral, and long-term health services to eligible Tennesseans.
- As the single state agency administering the Medicaid plan, TennCare houses the state funding used to pull down federal matching funds for various departments.
